# GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING COLLOQUIUM FACULTY OF LANGUAGES AND COMMUNICATION (FBK), UNISZA

## 1. Mode of Colloquium

FBK Postgraduate Committee (JKPS-FBK) offers three modes of colloquium as follows:

- 1. Physical
- 2. Online
- 3. Hybrid

## 2. Duration of the Colloquium Session

The suggested duration of each session is:

- 1. 1 hour for Proposal Defence (PD)
- 2. 1 hour and 30 minutes for for Pre Viva (PV)

#### 3. Members of PD Examiners Committee

The members of the Examiners Committee are:

- 1. Supervisor serves as the Chairperson
- 2. An examiner (Note: The examiner is the expert in the field, either from FBK, another faculty or other higher learning institutions).

## 4. Members of PV Examiners Committee

The members of the Examiners Committee are:

- 1. Supervisor serves as the Chairperson
- 2. Two Examiners (Note: The examiners are the expert in the field from FBK, or another faculty or from other higher learning institutions).

# 5. Conducting The Colloquium

## Before the Colloquium

- 1. The Secretariat ensures that the venue, facilities, and all technical aspects are ready for the colloquium. This includes the readiness of the presentation and Q&A in online and hybrid modes.
- 2. If the session is conducted in online and hybrid modes, the Secretariat will disseminate the link to the colloquium to the Chairperson and the audience one day before the colloquium.



- 3. The Chairperson of each session is responsible for informing the candidate about the colloquium link.
- **4.** The PD session is opened to all students and staff, while the PV session will be conducted among the PV Examiners Committee members **ONLY**.

## **Opening the Colloquium**

- 1. The Chairperson welcomes the audience and opens the session with Ummul Kitab.
- 2. The Chairperson introduces the Examiner(s), the candidate, and others before reading the title of the thesis.
- 3. If the session is conducted online/hybrid, the Secretariat records it for reference, and the Chairperson notifies all members beforehand.

## **During the Colloquium**

- 1. The Chairperson invites the candidate to commence the presentation (10 minutes for PD and 15 minutes for PV presentations).
- 2. The Chairperson acts as moderator, decision maker and time keeper to ensure the session runs smoothly.
- 3. After the presentation, the Chairperson invites all examiners to ask questions. The PD examiner is allocated 25 minutes, while the PV examiners are allocated 45 minutes for the Q&A. However, this time can be extended for a thorough examination of the thesis.
- 4. Within the allocated time, all examiners can take turns to ask questions and seek clarifications from the candidate regarding his/her work.
- 5. The Chairperson, cum the supervisor, remains silent during this session unless required to clarify issues raised by the examiners.

### 6. Closing the Colloquium

- 1. For PD, the Chairperson invites the audience to pose questions to the candidate. The allocated time for this session is 5 minutes.
- 2. The Chairperson summarises the Examiners' comments.
- 3. The Chairperson informs the Examiner(s) that the report (FBK-02) must be submitted within **THREE (3)** weeks after the colloquium date.
- 4. The Chairperson informs the candidate that the result will be emailed within **THREE**(3) weeks after the colloquium date.



5. For PV, the Chairperson informs the student to submit the Pre-Viva Corrections Form before proceeding with the Notice of Submission (NoS).

The Chairperson concludes the session with Tasbih Kafarah and Surah Al-As
